EXCELLENT HIP JOINT CONFORMATION

superior hip joint conformation as compared with
other individuals of the same breed and age

BORDERLINE HIP JOINT CONFORMATION

marginal hip joint conformation of indeterminate
status with respect to hip dysplasia at this time --
Repeat study in six months

GOOD HIP JOINT CONFORMATION

well formed hip joint conformation as compared
with other individuals of the same breed and age

MILD HIP DYSPLASIA

radiographic evidence of minor dysplastic
changes of the hip joints

FAIR HIP JOINT CONFORMATION

minor irregularities of the hip joint conformation as
compared with other individuals of the same
breed and age

MODERATE HIP DYSPLASIA

well defined radiographic evidence of dysplastic
changes of the hip joints

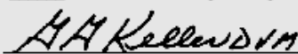
SEVERE HIP DYSPLASIA

radiographic evidence of marked dysplastic
changes of the hip joints
